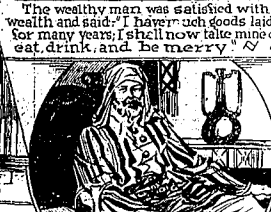

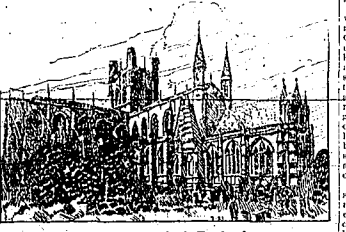

FAMOUS CHURCHES OF THE WORLD



Chester Cathedral, England.

Early in the tenth century, Ethelred the Baldorman, rebuilt an old church which existed at Chester for about a century previous to that time, and dedicated the new building to St. Werburgh, grand-daughter of King, the King of East Angles. His father began the work which was completed by St. Oswald. His foundation of secular canons flourished to the year 1065, when Hugh Avranches, founder of a Benedictine monastery at this place, this monastery, famous for its wealth, its fair and its miracle plays, was suppressed by King Henry VIII and part of its revenues devoted to the endowment of the new bishopric at Chester. Little record beyond this name survives to tell the history of the abbey and cathedral church. However, immense damage was inflicted on the buildings during the Civil War, during which Chester being the nearest port to Ireland, was a place of great strategic importance.

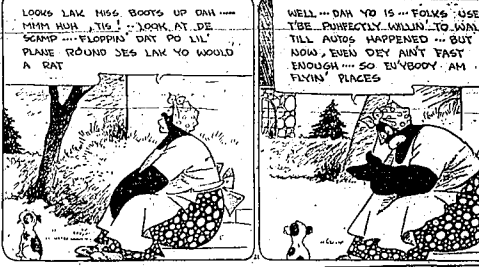
