SESSION CALLED TO SET QUOTAS OF PRODUCTION

Mussolini Assumes Lead for Italians; List of Needs Submitted

RULING BODY SUGGESTED

International Questions to Be Prime Factor

ROME, Mar. 26 (UPI)—Representatives of 46 nations assembled here Thursday to study methods for meeting the world wheat crisis.

Premier Mussolini inaugurated the wheat conference at the International Institute of Agriculture.

The United States was represented by an observer, Croce Simponi.

The Italian government took the initiative to deal with a situation that has forced recent parleying on the wheat question.

No fewer than 74 nations, dominions and autonomous territories received invitations to the conference.

Among the nations represented were Germany, Argentina, Bulgaria, France, England, India, Italy, Japan, South Africa, Britain, Russia, Greece, Mexico, Uruguay, Canada, Hungary, Holland, Poland, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey and Norway.

Mass. Observers

Participating as observers are representatives of the League of Nations; the International Chamber of Commerce and international commission of Agriculture.

The agenda is to be held before the conference.

International organization of agricultural production.

Organization of international monetary, credit for rural culture.

Organizations of international commerce in wheat.

Establishment of a world organization of civilization and determination of production quotas and international control of agriculture.

Point Two

The second point includes:

(a) "Reorganization of the organs of information already existing at the international institute of Agriculture and recognition of the right of the international organizations to collect and disseminate information."

(b) "Establishment of a financial organ responsible for collection, control and allocation of information, capital and credit resources."

The third point also includes:

the collection of data, market analysis, exchange and potential tariffs.

The conference is preparatory to a second conference of the same kind to be held in April.

It will be fixed during the present meeting.



SPUD SHIPMENTS SET NEW RECORD AS PRICE RISES

Report Shows 1,223 Carloads
Of Potatoes Shipped
In Last Week

IDAHO FALLS.—New shipment records were established by Idaho during the recent flurry of prices. The 25.3¢ advance of values last week, called out an exceptionally heavy supply of potatoes from the largest producing areas and also triggered all of the outlying sections. The weakening of the market late last week did not stop the momentum of price increases, due to new high levels, because of the fact that practically all of the carloads shipped were out of the state in previous orders.

Car lot trading was very heavy at local potato markets on Wednesday and Thursday. The peak of activity was followed closely by a sharp cutback, as farmers, who had been feeling they would do best to move their property before buying further supplies, held back. The total tonnage of each hauls was reported within the state on Saturday and Monday, although there were still some carloads left, with prices reasonably well maintained.

Idaho shipments last week were the heaviest of the season. The former high mark was 1,118 carloads established during the upper Snake River valley, loaded 710 tons of the total amount while the lower Snake valley and mixed territory with 24 carloads.

The market reports for last week were loaded with 256 carloads and around Salmon City, although an occasional car came in from northern Idaho. Some additional carloads were added to the upper valley loadings by cars originating from eastern Washington. The loading previously recorded in one day was 23 carloads, established twice during the 1927-28 season.

On the other hand, 258 carloads were shipped off last week, while 24 carloads were shipped off the state, and this new mark was beaten.

The record for the highest number of carloads shipped in one day was set at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Glenn Cox Sunday for a sumptuous birthday dinner in honor of Mr. Cox.
