That he will run again is inconceivable indicated by the non-sense like the recent offer. His platform and campaign can be repeated. It will be the same old story.

At this time his error. The nation has learned the apple sauce. It has felt the talons of those who put the Hoover myth to rest. The farmer can't be fooled twice. WHAT OF 1931?

INDICATIONS of 1931 being a "good year" are seen on every hand.

To begin with, it is logical to assume that following depressed conditions in practically all lines, times will adjust themselves for the better instead of for the worse, the strenuous efforts being made to restore normalcy will meet with some degree of success and that the experiences of the past year will have taught lessons bound to be of benefit in the restoration of soundness in industry and in agriculture generally.

Although discouraging reports continue to come from the middle-west in regard to the prolongation of the drought, there is one phase of that situation which can be construed as helpful to us here; and that is the well-known proposition of crop damage in one locality helping growers in the favored sections, such as south central Idaho. To offset the advantages to our section of continued crop damage in the middle-west, is the lessened buying power which such a condition causes.

The upset which has come to the bean market, wheat market, sugar, market and potato market, is material in scope, of course, and is certain to be changed this crop year. For instance wheat acreage is going to be reduced, sugar beet prices are set in advance, and it is likely the acreage of beans and potatoes will be greatly reduced this year as the result of last year's experience.

Here sits southern Idaho with assurance of ample water, despite a shortage in the watershed and fortunately having a variety of crops from which to choose in contrast to other sections, which regularly depend on single crops, like wheat, or cotton, or corn or tobacco.

Southern Idaho can raise potatoes, beans, wheat, oats, small seed, sugar beets, corn, hay, fruit, vegetables, berries and livestock and poultry. If ever a year indicated the advantages of diversification, 1931 is that year. And despite the fact that the dairying and poultry business has suffered up to now along with agriculture in general, is all the more reason for ranchers generally getting into those branches of farming all the deeper while values are low.

Southern Idaho has much to look forward to this year. Without being unduly optimistic it is safe to predict that, comparatively speaking, this section will hold its own with most any section in the United States this year. The moving of potatoes right now at fair prices, the stiffening of the bean market, the efforts being made to get government advances on the crop, and the wonderful snowfall of this week, are all encouraging evidences for an encouraging year.

Nature appears to be doing its share. Combine with this the mind and hands of a determined agriculture to do its very best and to put forth its utmost energy in taking advantage of its limitless resources, there is bound to result a better 1931 than 1930, for the nation and the world now has a keener and better estimate of the importance of agriculture than ever before and will hereafter be willing to adequately compensate and assist it on its way to prosperity.

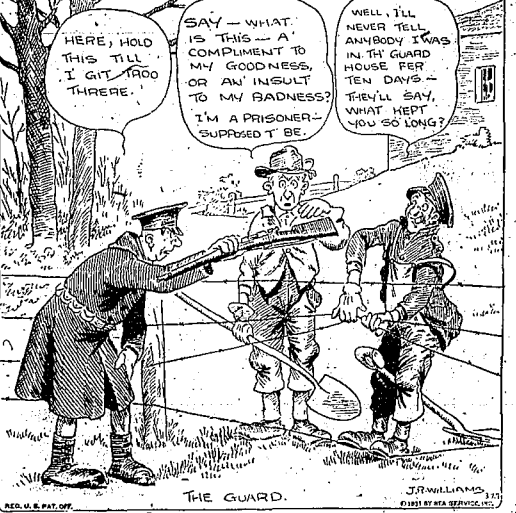
