GENERAL BUTLER ANSWERS ATTACK ON HAITI SERVICE

U. S. To Probe Charge Marine Was Fictitious Hero In Charge on Fort

HAITI MINISTER BLAMED

Fury Leader Hands in Eye-Witness Accounts

WASHINGTON, Apr. 25 (UPI)—Secretary of the Navy Adams has referred to the state department a letter from Major General Butler, U.S.A., in which he inquires as to the course of action the government will take in view of the statements made about his record in Haiti.

Secretary of State Stimson said he would make a thorough investigation. Pardon this investigation, Stimson added.

The statements in question alleged that Major General Butler, during his service in Haiti, informed to the United States, in a newspaper interview, that he had been awarded the Medal of Honor.

State Department Probe

A letter concerning statements attributed to the minister from Haiti has been received by the secretary of state. Major General Butler, United States Marine Corps, a statement today by Acting Secretary of the Navy Adams.

NEW YORK, Apr. 25 (UPI)—A daring \$85,000 jewelry store robbery, staged on a busy uptown corner, caused a stir in the financial district, but a moderately calm today to a series of gamblers who have netted the unscrupulous hundred thousand dollars recently.

THE CAUSE OF CRIME

No more pictures dealing with the underworld will be produced by the Paramount-Publix Corporation. S. R. Kent, vice president in charge of distribution, made this announcement the other day—taking pains, at the same time, to deny emphatically that gangster movies have been responsible for crime waves.

This action came only a few days after Police Commissioner Mulroney of New York had charged that motion pictures and tabloid newspapers were chiefly responsible for the increase of crime among city youth.

Mr. Kent, explaining his company's action, said that crime pictures have been overdone and the public is tired of them. Thus, while he does not accept Commissioner Mulroney's criticism, he at least takes an action that ought to help make the community happy.

The general public probably will welcome a diminution in the number of gangster movies. The general public is at least partially in agreement with the New York police commissioner; and the whole business needs a little more intelligent consideration than usually gets.

An impressionable youngster may, now and then, be led into crime by a lurid movie; but in general it is safe to say that blaming the movies for the gang wars of the big cities is nothing but an easy way out of a perplexing situation.

"As long as we can soothe our conscience by an "explanation" of that kind, we shall continue to have crime wives. Indeed, one of the big reasons for bad crime conditions in American cities is the fact that all of us are content to find some obvious scapegoat like the moving picture.

We blame the movie and the tabloid and conveniently forget about the bad housing conditions that provide crime with its best spawning ground.

We blame the movie and the tabloid and overlook the fact that half a dozen good playgrounds, properly placed and rightly directed, would do more to keep children from going astray than all the "uplift" in the world.

"We blame the movie and the tabloid and shun our eyes to the fact that every one of us who buys a pint of gin helps to pay for the upkeep of the army of professional bootleggers.

We overlook the social and economic conditions that produce big city gangs — because fixing those conditions so that they would no longer produce gangs would be altogether too much trouble. Being lazy, we prefer to put up with the criminal. Why not blame them on the movies and the newspapers? It's so much easier.

It's just about time that we gave up these cheap excuses. The roots of organized crime today go right to the foundations of American society. Cheap movies have no more to do with it than the price of bustles in Afghanistan.

SANDINO

"I AM confident Sandino will be brought to justice," says President Hoover in a review of the situation regarding the insurgent Nicaraguan general.

The President says:

Our advices are that the Nicaraguan government has now placed in the field a total of over 1,300 men of the newly created national guard in a drive to "clean up Sandino and his fellow bandits."

Our representatives advise that this force is several times that of Sandino and his bands. His bands upon important points have been frustrated by the dispositions of the guard and protection of our citizens on the coast is made doubly sure by the presence of our naval vessels.

Sandino has placed himself and his band outside the civilized pale by the cold-blooded murder of eight or nine American civilians and many Nicaraguans at isolated places in the interior.

The Nicaraguan government has shown itself fully cognizant of its responsibilities. It is moving vigorously despite the difficulties created by the earthquake. While it may require some time to accomplish their purpose due to the mountainous and jungle character of the country, I am confident that Sandino will be brought to justice.

Surely the people of that Central American country have enough to contend with without the additional necessity of defending themselves against the onslaughts of a bandit general.

Widespread cooperation is due the Magdalens and their local organizations in the campaign to give the entire thorough cleaning up. Boy Scouts are doing their part and citizens generally should assist, not only for the moral benefits but if nothing more, probably because a vacant lot, slums and numerous persons of questionable character who ever heard of a city being too clean for the magicians to do the trick?
