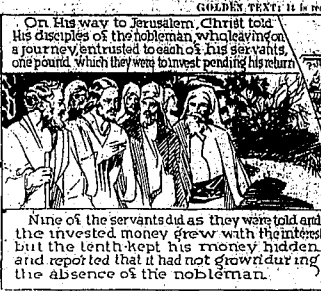

Nine of the servants did as they were told and the invested money grew with interest but the tenth kept his money hidden, and reported that it had not grown during the absence of the nobleman.

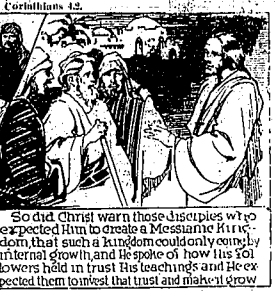

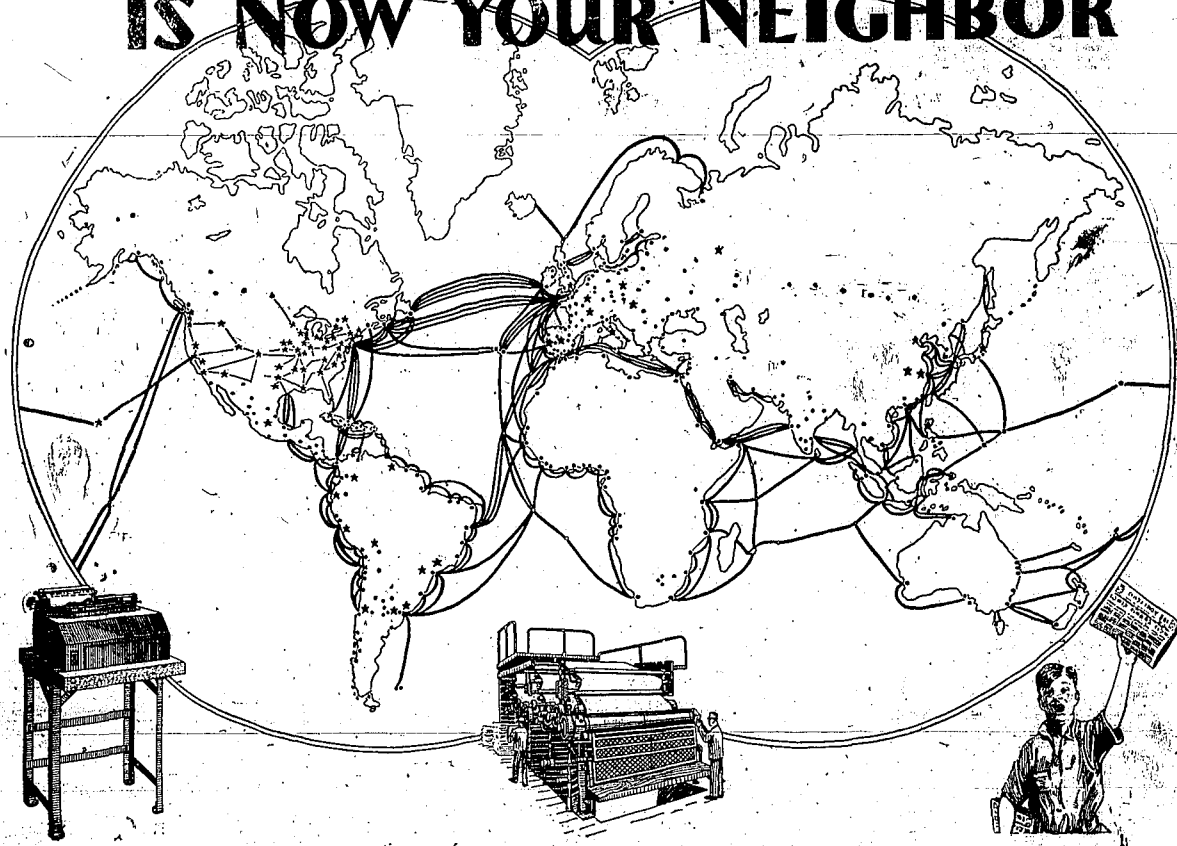
