## CHICAGO BROKE, BANKERS REFUSE FURTHER LOANS

City and County Unable to Pay Employees and School Teachers

## APPEALS BRING SIGHS

Financiers Sorry But Not Able to Aid

CHICAGO, May 19. (UPI)—The financial condition of Chicago, and Cook county cannot be averted to day, but the bankers are holding back with each other to "dig us some way out quickly before we all collapse together."

"Conditions are so bad," the mayor said, "that I can't talk about it until we find a way out."

# SHORT COURSE FOR 4-H CLUBS STARTS JUNE 7

Four-Day Session to Attract  
20 Delegates from Twin  
Falls County

**POCATELLO, May 19** (Special)—The third annual junior 4-H club short course will be held at the University of Idaho southern branch, June 7 to 11 at Pocatello.

One hundred and sixty delegates from 20 local 4-H clubs throughout south central Idaho, representing 1,000 members, will enroll with the district extension agent at Durley by June 1 to begin the four-day course. There are 60 delegates from Canyon, Cassia, Jerome, Gooding and Lincoln counties, each club sending two delegates that have been held in the past two years. Registration will be held Saturday morning at 9 a.m., during which members and leaders will be addressed by Dean E. L. Durley, University of Idaho branch, and C. H. Anderson, who will speak on "Chances will start at 8 o'clock Monday morning and continue until

Special exhibits and demonstrations will be followed by meetings for local leaders and rest and recreation periods.
