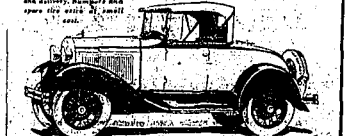

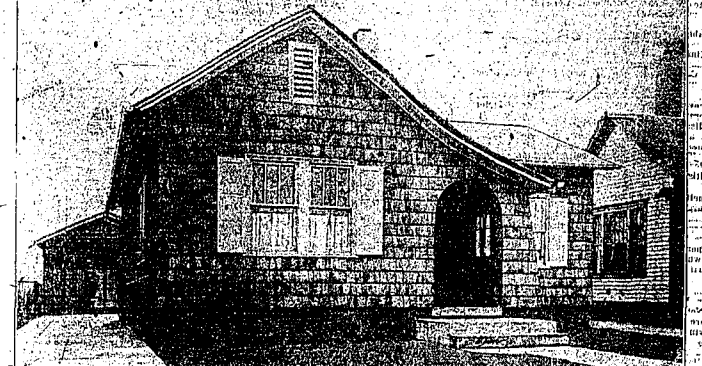

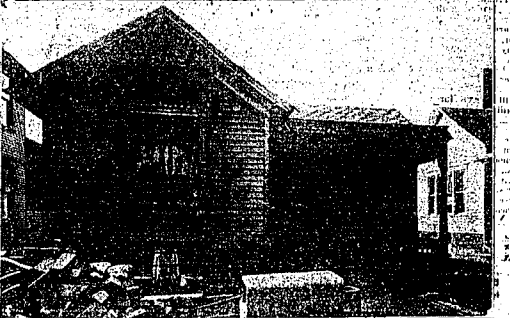

POVERTY AND CRIME

POVERTY, misery and crime go hand in hand. They form such a closely-knit triumvirate that one sometimes is forced to believe that most of the so-called wickedness, perversity and general cussedness of the human race vanish from the scene if only economic conditions could be improved sufficiently.

A few days ago the health council of a representative American city submitted its report on the city's "submerged tenth"—the very poorest class, which occupies a part of the town that sociologists have dubbed the "economic graveyard."

Twenty thousand people live in this particular section. They make up 10 per cent of the city's population. Listen to some of the figures about them: To begin with, this 10 per cent of the city's inhabitants occupies only 6 per cent of the city's area. It contributes 11 per cent of the city's births, but only 6 per cent of the hospital births. It has 16 per cent of the infants' deaths, 18 per cent of the city's total unemployed and 24 per cent of the charity cases. It furnishes 17 per cent of the city's illegitimate births, 20 per cent of its juvenile delinquency cases, 35 per cent of its murders and 49 per cent of its houses of prostitution.

A glance at those figures is enough to show the inequalities that vice, crime and general all-around unappiness and misery make on the economically underprivileged. The child born in such an area does not get a fair chance in life. The cards are stacked against him from the beginning.

Nor is that all. The more fortunate man, who lives miles from such a neighborhood and grows to manhood without ever missing a meal or spending a night in jail, is affected by that neighborhood's existence far more than he usually imagines.

Because of this submerged and poverty-stricken group in his town, his taxes are higher. Because of the crime-breeding conditions that prevail there, his chances of getting held up by a bandit some day are higher than they should be.

Such an area, in other words, is a point of infection; a plague spot, influencing the entire city. No city can be healthy when poverty exists on any considerable number of its inhabitants.

HIGHWAYS

Increased interest in the development of Highway No. 99, running north and south through here between the Canadian line and the southern border of the United States is a vital factor in the development of this section and its roadways.

The building of the highway is being brought about even faster than its most ardent sponsors could have hoped for, with much of the Idaho sector already well underway and Nevada and Montana doing their level best to keep up with the procession.

With a state highway administration in full sympathy with the move, and local advocates of good roads alert to the needs of the community, there should be no fear that this county will not get its full share of cooperation just as soon as it is financially possible and when the state highway program is fully mapped out.

Connected with large demands for roads, a comparatively small amount of capital on hand at the time the new administration took office, the necessity for meeting payments on the million dollar highway anticipation notes, and with tax money for road purposes lagging until late summer, the department is pushing its program with business-like care and in full regard to the interests of the various sections, all of whom would like their roads at one and the same time.

That steady advancement is being made on Highway 99 is a source of local pride. The knowledge that this county is deserving of all the attention possible in the matter of any available funds from out-of-county sources shared by the present state administrative heads, and that they may be depended upon to leave nothing undone in that regard for this important section goes without saying.

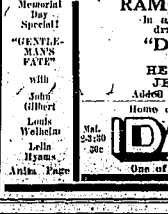
