AIR CORPS GAINS LISTED BY ARMY AVIATION HEADS

Reviews Show New Strength Has Been Added to U. S. Defense - Defense - NEW GUNS SUCCESSFUL .50 Caliber Bullet Used on Planes

WASHINGTON, June 4 (AP) - Under the impetus of the five-year expansion plan adopted by Congress in 1926, the army air corps has been vastly strengthened in the new year by department aviation experts.

While holding still more planes and officers is necessary for a well-rounded military air defense, the air corps, in summarizing its activities for the last few years, pointed to what it considered rapid progress both in technical equipment and in able pilots.

Under the five-year plan, adopted in 1926, but not put into effect until 1927, the air corps was to have 1,500 aviators, 1,000 regular officers, 550 reserve officers and 10,000 enlisted men by 1932. The material program has gone forward according to schedule, save for a few delays.

Five planes, construction of which was delayed until 1931 because of an anticipated treasury deficit at that time in the 1922-budget was drawn.

Lacks Sufficient Planes

According to the present schedule of increase, the air corps will have in 1930 a total of 1,600 enlisted men in 1932, but is likely to be short 200 officers because Congress has not provided for increased sufficient planes to keep 500 reserve officers on duty constantly, officials fear.

Air corps officers take particular pride in the technical advances made in fighting planes during the last two years. In 1929, they built out, partly along the coast, a plane of 166 miles per hour; now it is 192, able to climb, 10,000 feet in 10 minutes, and of a constant plane, has also been improved. New pursuit ships can go up to 20,000 feet, compared with 21,000 two years ago.

Stuntman, armament has been made more deadly. In 1928, pursuit planes carried two .50-caliber machine guns capable of firing 2,500 yards. Now a .50-caliber gun has replaced the lighter kind, bringing greater accuracy. A .50-caliber bullet is no larger than one finger's width with a force of 600 lbs.

Bombs Also Improved

Bombs, too, have been improved. A new super-bomb now has been designed, capable of carrying 10,000 pounds of explosives on a lift of an airplane wing. Modern pursuit planes, instead of carrying bombs, carry a variety of bombs within close range of a bombing formation and expending them by machine gun fire, can bombard bombers from a safe altitude, officers point out.

Bombing planes now carry six men, speed 150 miles per hour and carry 4,000 pounds of bombs. More they carry a variable amount to fight off enemy attack-forty machine guns, advanced guns mounted to fire at nearly any angle.

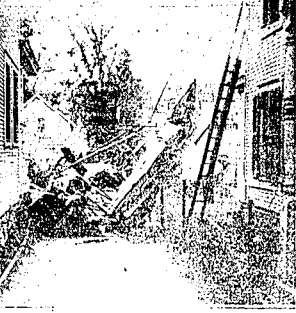

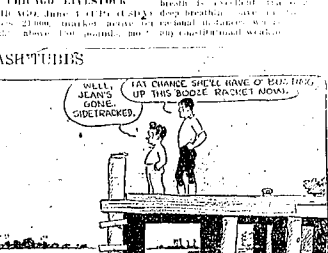

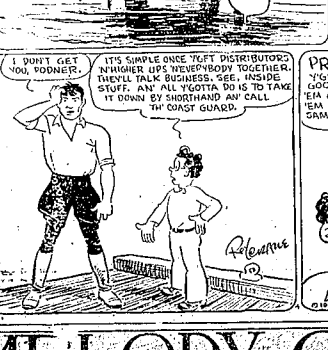
