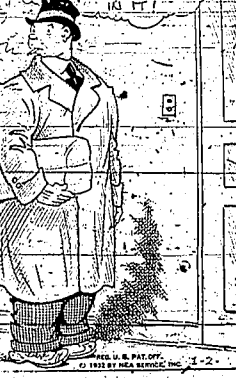

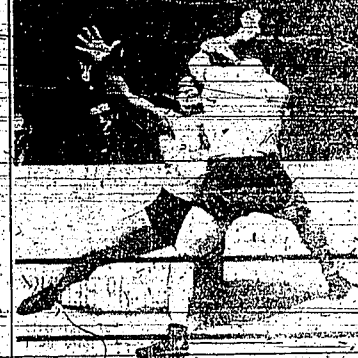

BLESSINGS

Grazing land is benefited, as are the forests; the fire hazards are lessened; and dry-farming is given a needed lift.

The slight inconvenience which storms occasion, such as closed highways, cold weather, minor accidents and small losses from damages, are inconspicuous compared to the great resources of plentiful water supply in the mountains.

This is the new year ushered in under the most auspicious circumstances possible for an irrigated empire, instilling new hopes and courage. It is people who have placed their earthly dependence almost entirely upon the God-given waters which annually issue from the majestic Tetons, Sawtooths and other mountain ranges.

FARM BOY VS. CITY BOY

ALBERT H. Wiggin, chairman of the Chase National Bank of New York, declared in an interview published by World's Work magazine recently that country boys, for some reason, seem to make better bankers than city boys.

Of the men in control of New York's 18 leading banks, he points out, not one was born on Manhattan Island. Most of them came from small towns.

Here, surely, is material for plenty of speculation. It all lines up with one of the oldest American traditions—that the country boy is apt to be a little sharper, a little more ambitious, a little more capable, than the boy from the city.

It is used to be supposed that there were more self-denial and more discipline in the country than in the city. Certainly the young men in a fine training school for any youngster.
