 Depression Has Focused Attention On American School Children

WASHINGTON—The constant increase in school enrollment has been conspicuously accelerated by the depression and children of this school age have been receiving an unprecedented amount of attention because of the recognized harmful effects of such depression on child children that children were not work on one-fifth of last year's level.
