

# DEMPSEY RISKS FUTURE CAREER

## Jack Comes To Crossroads In Four Round Fight With Levinsky

CHICAGO, (UP)—Almost 4 1/2 years after a four-round boxing fight for the famous "fourteen count," Jack Dempsey will make his appearance in a Chicago ring in fighting recall tonight against Gene Levinsky, ranked No. 1 in the world by the National Boxing Association.

The match is billed as a 4-round exhibition, but it has all the aspects of a real fight. Both fighters will receive 25 cents per round, 25 cents over the regulation size, but not large to prevent a crowd from inflicting damage of scoring a knockout.

A crowd of 25,000, the largest ever to see an indoor boxing match, will attend and enable Dempsey, most popular fighter of all time, to complete the cycle of boxing in the United States and the British Empire in advertising.



Major General Tashiro arrived at the Chinese headquarters in Shanghai but is reported to have slipped a large map of the Shanghai area on Gen. Wu's desk. The map revealed heavy lines across his yellow and white face.  
"There is a permanent demilitarized zone which you must respect," the Japanese officer said.  
Chinese told the correspondent that compliance with the demands without effort, resistance, would be impossible. In other words, the Chinese will not comply unless they are forced.




