DEFEAT OF SALES TAX DIMS LUSTER OF JOHN N. GARNER

Democrats Suffer Setback When House Strike Out Provision

WAS VEHICLE OF SELF-EXPRESSION

Plan Had Aroused Fears of Folks 'Back Home' Writ or Assets

WASHINGTON (UPI)—The Democratic party's march up the presidential hill of 1932 has been thrown into temporary confusion by the defeat of the sales tax to the House.

The party's proud shock troops, constituting the Democratic House majority, who were busily engaged in the effort to vindicate their party's economic rule, had to suspend their show temporarily while the scattered fragments were picked up and put together again.

On the incidental, easily visible Speaker John N. Garner, whose presidential boot was bounding along on the reputation he was making for the inviolate House's perfect driving. His luster is not bright today.

May Fight Way Out

It is not necessarily a fatal mishap that has befallen the Democratic Republicans have the right to vote out of power confusion. Democrats have ample opportunity to do likewise.

The Democratic leaders advanced a tax program which aroused the strongest opposition. POLICE SURPRISE RUM RUNNERS; GET MUCH LIQUOR

\$250,000 Worth of Assorted Contraband Seized In Connecticut

Billy Petrole Wins By a Technical Knockout in Final Round.

NEW YORK (UPI) — A special train rolled out of New York for Hartford, Conn., early today, carrying home a rare delegation of eight fans, heavy-hearted because they had seen Christopher "Bat" Battalino, former featherweight champion, lose to Billy Petrole of Fargo, North Dakota.

Bat lost on the last round of his scheduled 15-round bout, when a referee stopped the bout to save him from further punishment.

They fought at Madison Square Garden in a near record crowd of 12,000, in a cramped fight scene where Petrole outshone Jimmy McLarion some.

McLarion, like Petrole, gave Petrole the licking, but Petrole's tailing made a unexpected exception of courage and panache.

Petrole won the fight on Battalino's nose. The so-called "Petticoat" option was cut on the third of Battalino's nose early in the second round.

Blood began to flow immediately and, except for two seconds between rounds, continued to do so.

Battalino during the fight, his nose was broken in two places. He lost between a point of blood and was knocked down three times with assistance, was he able to stagger from the ring.

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Growers intend to plant 53.3 percent more wheat acreage this year than in 1931, the U.S. Department of agriculture reported Thursday. During wheat planting intent is said for 31.8 percent increase over 1931.

Planting intent in plant 10.2 per cent of last year's acreage, the board also reported.

Continuing it says it is interested in fair political play in Idaho, particularly when it involves the most important governmental subject which confronts the harassed citizenry of the Gem state—taxation.

To quote the Tribune, further:

"In line with this policy it is proper to direct attention to a series of particularly abusive and unfair editorials which have been published by the Idaho Statesman, southern Idaho's leading newspaper, and mimicked by lesser fry in that field. The burden of the Statesman's diatribe is the state income tax, in particular that citizens of the state are compelled to pay this tax this spring in addition to the regular ad valorem real estate and personal property levies. The Statesman harps with delight on the fact that the income tax bill is entitled 'The Property Relief' Act of 1931."

But the Statesman is not content with one-sided criticism of the income tax law. Because the incumbent favored this act it belittles and flings dirt at the state's highest officer, the governor.

Old Publisher Cobb, we fear, would turn in his grave were he aware of the unworthy devices to which his good newspaper has fallen. He wielded a biting pen, often a bitter one, but never did he permit nose-thumbing, back-biting, disparagement.

FASCISM AND THE COMMON MAN

THE antics of Fascist leaders in Europe would not mean much on this side of the Atlantic were it not for the fact that there are a good many Americans who are inclined to believe that Fascism does have its uses as an antidote to Bolshevism.

That the Fascists in Italy choked off radicalism at a crucial moment is obvious. The question, however, is whether the cure is not worse than the disease.

Just now Germany is having a chance to digest the revelations that followed a series of raids on the headquarters of Hitler's organization. They make significant and ominous reading.

A plot to plunge Germany into civil war and seize the government by force was discovered; and the plot was typical of Fascism in all countries. Rejected by the voters at the polls, Fascism would take the offices it wants anyway—for one of the hallmarks of the Fasisti is that he is always quite sure that he knows just exactly what ought to be done for his fellow-citizens and is willing to do it for them regardless of their wishes.

All of this, in other words, simply emphasizes anew the fact that Fascism is as complete a denial of freedom, democracy and individual rights as Communism is. And it comes from the same conditions that produce Communism.

Each of these divergent philosophies of government is a philosophy of despair. Men do not become Fascists, or Communists, unless they are convinced that things are so very bad that they could not possibly get any worse. Hitler may have lost the election in Germany, but the size of the vote he polled shows that an enormous proportion of German's citizens had reached the point at which they were willing to put their destinies in his hands.

And the whole thing, boiled down, resolves itself into a salutary warning for people on this side of the ocean.

Fascism, like Bolshevism, is a sign that a nation is deathly sick. It is as violent, as ruthless and as dictatorial as Bolshevism is; it means revolution just as surely as Bolshevism does; it is just as fatal to the common man's rights.
