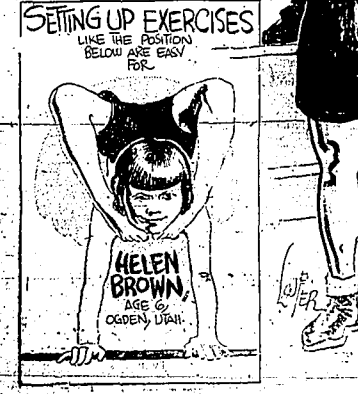

Enters Turf Hall of Fame

**LOUISVILLE, Ky., (AP)**—Burgoo King, the horse who drew his name from the length of the burgoo country today had a win in the turf hall of fame and a flying start toward the 2-year-old championship of 1932.

Whispering as he paced in a flying start toward the stretch, Burgoo King today won the 56th Kentucky derby, which gave Col. E. B. Bradley of Lexington, Ky., and Palm Beach, Fla., his third derby triumph and became the second son of a derby winner ever to follow in the wake of his daddy.

Burgoo King, son of Lou Over, 1926 derby winner, won by five lengths, running a mile and a quarter in 2 minutes, 6 1/2 seconds, slow time in comparison to Twenty Grand's derby record of 2:01 1/2 last year, but considerably above the average set by winner of a derby winner ever to follow in the wake of his daddy.

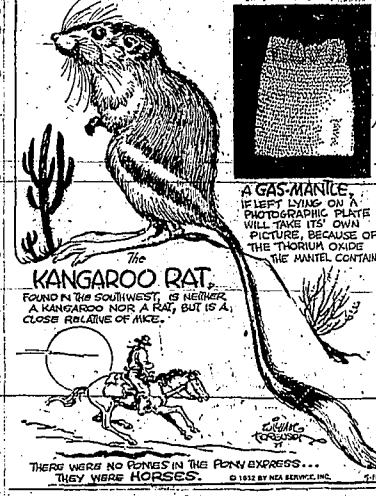

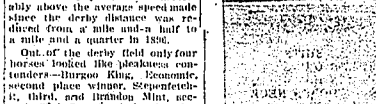
