NEW YORK (UPI) — Bank accounts and financial transactions of friends of Mayor James J. Walker were further revealed today by U.S. Senator Emanuel Seidensticker, delved more deeply into investigation of the city administration before the House Select committee.

35 COUNTY LAMB GRUVERS SHARE IN POOL RECEIPTS

Two Garments Containing 543
Head Are Marketed In
Denver

Returns on shipment of two garments recently by the Twin Falls County Lamb Pool association have been received; it was reported at the office of the American Legion, 3rd and Main Tuesday.

"One car was sent from Butte and one from Twin Falls, and were to be marketed in Denver on the Denver market last week."

The Twin Falls car, according to officials of the pool, netted \$4.43 per ewt, or a full weight basis, equivalent to 44 cents per pound. The 3 per cent surcharge basis. The actual shrinkage was 0.68 per cent. Shipping charges were 22 cents a pound.

Eighteen per cent fewer passenger vehicles and trucks have been licensed in Twin Falls county to date this year than at the same time last year, figures were received at the office of S. E. In 1931 there were a total of 7,522 automobile registrations in Twin Falls, and 1,172 trucks. Fees collected were \$157,549.91.
