

Joe McCarthy's Nine Needs Four Victories To Eliminate Rivals

Yanks Increase Lead to 13 1/2 Games Over A's

CHICAGO GAINS

NEW YORK (UPI)—Four victories in their remaining 12 games will bring the New York Yankees permanent lead over the Chicago White Sox...

Only two wins are necessary to eliminate the runner-up Philadelphia Athletics, but four are called to blot out the third-place Washington Senators from the pennant picture.

Joe McCarthy's Yankees increased their lead to 13 1/2 games over the A's yesterday when they won the first game of a schedule double-header from Detroit, 6 to 4 after 14 innings. The victory was called at the end of the seventh because of darkness with the score 7 to 7.

The Athletics dropped a 2-1 decision to Cleveland, where Clint Hurrh limited the A's to four hits.

Yankees' Weaver held the Browns to four hits while winning his 20th game of the season for Washington, 7 to 7.

Chicago's White Sox improved to a 1-3 victory over the St. Louis Cardinals.

The Chicago Cubs extended their National league lead to five and one-half games over the Pirates by splitting a seven-inning doubleheader with the Pirates last, a game in Brooklyn.

Bruce Serrano of the St. Louis Cardinals took the opening 4 to 2 lead in the eighth, but the Pirates' Bill Skowron tied the game, 2 to 2.

Harold Glimco of the St. Louis Cardinals threw his second shutout by leading the Cardinals to a 3-0 victory over the Philadelphia Phillies.

Yesterday's hero: Lefty O'Doul of Brooklyn who drove in four runs with two homers and two singles in four tries, raising his batting average to .376. He costered the St. Louis hit of the season.

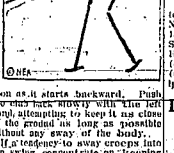
