

Inner Defense of Cubs Expected to Outshine Yankees' in Big Series

Lou Gehrig's Hitting Hard to Overcome However

 CHICAGO, (UP)—The New York Yankees have an inside chance of the greatest slugger in all baseball history, in their "Big Five" and Chicago Cubs haven't a hitter on their entire team to compare with him. There's no one else that's hard to overtake, but capturing the hearts of the two prospective "Big Five" players will prove an arduous task, either offensively or defensively, the Cubs' manager has no concrete anything on the Yankees' combination.

Averages show the Cubs are better both at bat and in the field, and many New York servers think the Chicago squares will prove it in the forthcoming world series.

But with a slugger like Gehrig around one major blow from the Yankees can make a lot of fairly holding plays.

The Yankees infield is older. New York's veteran, Frank Crosetti, New York's shortstop, and many New York's other infielders have played in three or four world series, while the Cubs' infielders, including Gehrig and Lazear, have played in three.

Joe Sewell has played in two, and the Cubs' Mark Koenig, who played with Gehrig and Lazear in the 1928 series, has played in one series. Lazear averaged 225 in his three, and Koenig 232, but the latter was the hitting star of the 1927 series with an average of .306. English, who played with Sewell and Koenig, averaged .287 in the 1929 series.

Diply Harmon, who scored twice in the 1929 series, has played in one series, and Frank Crowell, who has never seen a world series, averaged .287 in the 1929 series.
