SPEAKER CHARGED WITH ERRORS IN CAMPAIGN TALKS

Group Answers Statements Attributed to Critic of Officials

Expressing condemnation of statements attributed to a Republican campaign speaker in this county, supporters of a group of county candidates which has even called his sanity have made known their views as follows:

"Just to keep the record straight, and in justice to a group of county officials who have lately been publicly criticized, the following facts are given:

"The statement that the county was increased when those of us were in the office of county clerk, or referred, is not in fact true.

"The claim that payment of a \$2,000 obligation of the county should not have been made until a resolution was passed and is unsupported by law, and in addition would have been unconstitutional.

"Alleges charges for the year 1931 were in fact less than were those of the preceding year under a Republican administration.

"The statement that all taxing units expelling the county have recovered their money in full from closed banks is an accurate statement. The inference that the county treasury office does not properly verify interest certificates of common school districts in these units is misleading for the reason that the treasurer is not responsible for such certificates.

"And to cap the climax, even such elementary figures as county road mileage are incorrectly verified, an utter lack of familiarity with laws, information, and precedent attempt to discredit and mislead. Percentages reported on general fund items are incorrect and are not based on fact by the recorder.

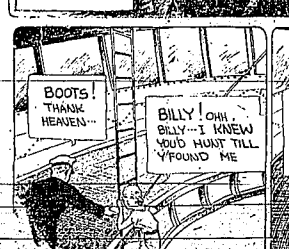
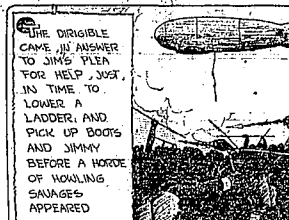

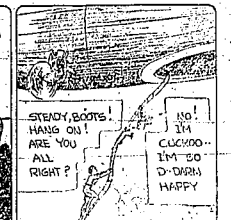
