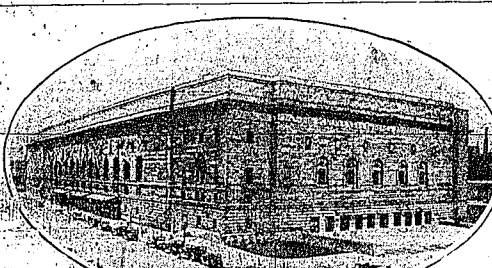
Home Loan Bank System Begins Operations Today

W. D. Vincent, Driver of Car, and Mrs. Vincent Hurt; Tragedy Occurs Near Pocatello Saturday Morning

POCAHELLO, (UP)—C. E. Bocock, 56, president of Albin Normal and Mrs. Retta Martin, 60, Democratic nominee for superintendent of public instruction were killed in an automobile crash, five miles north of Pocatello on the highway early today.

W. D. Vincent, commissioner of education of Idaho and Mrs. Vincent, were severely injured. They were rushed to Lynn brothers hospital where they are suffering from bruises and cuts.

The party of four was en route to St. Anthony after attending the district Idaho teachers convention in Pocatello.

Vincent was about to pass a car driven by E. A. Crane, Pocatello, when the car started to make a left turn onto a cross road. Three persons in the Crane car told officers that the driver signalled to turn right.

Vincent saw he could not pass the Crane car on the left and swerved his car to the right. The machine plunged off the highway, after sliding 50 feet, and crashed into the concrete abutment of a siphon.

The terrific impact threw Mrs. Martin and Bocock out of the car. Mrs. Martin died later en route to the Pocatello hospital. Mrs. Vincent suffered a skull fracture and possibly internal injuries.

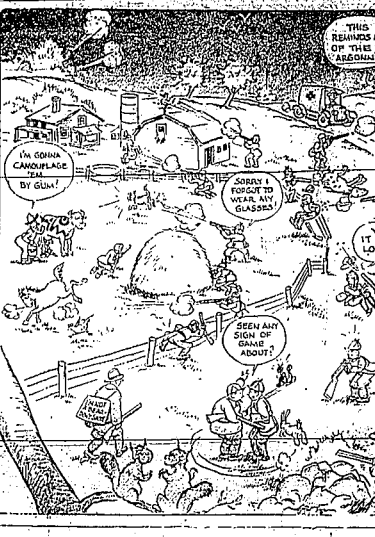
