AMERICA ACTS TO CURB SEA FLIGHTS

Publicity Stunt:
Hops Scored As
Five Lose Lives

WASHINGTON—Publicity, aimed at ocean-faring flying which reached a peak during the past five months, may be severely curtailed in the future.

The Commerce and State Departments have agreed to take steps adequate to reduce the risk of such flights and to eliminate foolhardiness from them as far as possible.

Since Nov. 24, 26 women and children have attempted to fly across the Atlantic Ocean. Only 10 of these flights were successful; 17 who failed were lost at sea, and 10, including Colonel George Hutchins, were saved.

There ought to be a preventative regulation calling for certain qualifications of plane, pilot and equipment. In this connection, the story of completing the trip according to Colonel Clarence M.
