He called for a return to the principles of the Constitution and for a more active role for the federal government. His speech was met with a storm of applause and was one of the most successful in the history of the state.

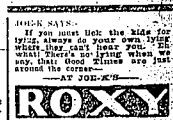

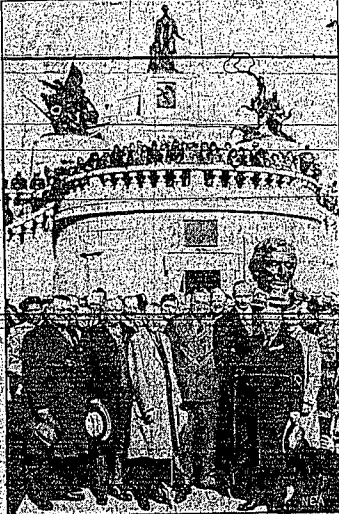
