"Approximately three-fifths of those who voted at the polls last Tuesday night in the five institutional amendment ballots presented them, and to their voices, a resounding endorsement of the fast-completed law, have registered decisions on the five proposals as follows:

"I. J. H. No. 2—Restricting voters at irrigation district election to those who are members of the district. Voted for. Total, 1,476; against, 1,176.

"I. J. H. No. 3—Abolishing state board of education and setting up a state commission. Voted for, 2,719; no, 3,857.

"I. J. H. No. 4—Allowing voters at irrigation district election to choose their own commissioners. Voted for, 1,200; against, 1,200.

"I. J. H. No. 5—Giving legislative authority to impose taxes on incomes, sales, privileges, es-
capes, etc., to provide funds for
constitutional cities, towns and other
municipal corporations." Voted 2,538;
no, 3,864.
