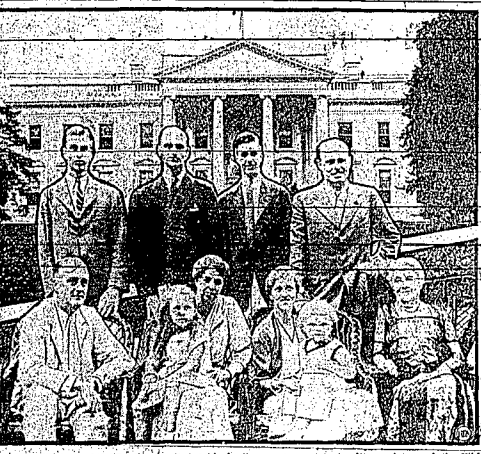

### VANDALS BOAST FINE RECORD IN BOISE CONTESTS

No Rocky Mountain Conference Team Has Beaton Idaho at Capital

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO, MOSCO—When the University of Idaho Vandals face the Utah Aztecs in Boise on Thanksgiving day they will be out to make a tradition: No Rocky Mountain team has ever beaten Idaho at Boise.

From 1922 to 1929 the Vandals appeared eight times in the National Capital. They defeated the University of Oregon and Nevada once each, Wyoming secured three points on Idaho in 1922 in a game which ended in a 0-0 tie for the Vandals. This year will be the first meeting between Idaho and Utah Agricultural College.

Three Vandals will have a victory and a half of concentrated drill for the Aztecs game. Assistant Coach George Wilson, who coached the Aztecs in their game with the University of Utah, Rocky Mountain champion, believes the U. S. A. team could put up a strong battle against any Pacific coast outfit. Utah won the game 10 to 0 but only after being outplayed and nullified by the Aztecs' equal for three quarters of the contest.

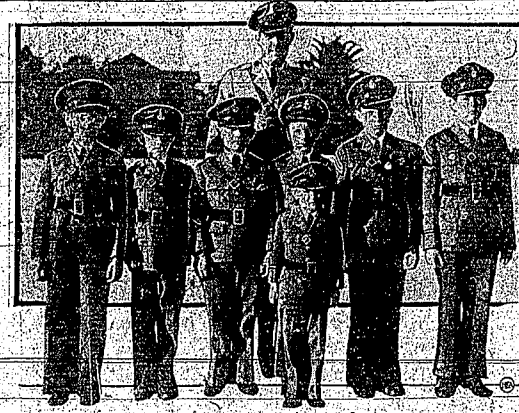
