## Waterfowl Trapped in Oregon Ice

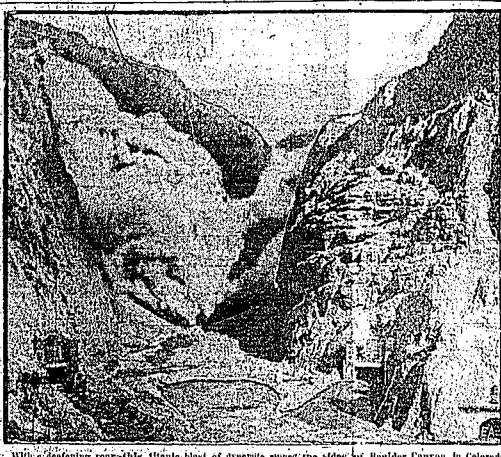
