

COAST OFFICIALS NAME HERB DANA AS COMMISSIONER

Famous Referee Will Pick
Men to Officiate at
Future Contests

LOS ANGELES (UPI)—Pacific coast conference officials concluded their first meeting yesterday, naming Herb Dana, ranking coast football official, as conference commissioner at their opening session.

Dana, who will superintend in football, basketball, baseball and what not, preceding on the gridiron, will have the new job of selecting officials for the conference games. Dana himself will be disqualified from officiating not only on the gridiron, but also in basketball, baseball and tennis. His office will be set up at Oskaloosa, the first of the year. In October, his salary was not disclosed.

Dana, named a non-voting delegate, planned to let conference games to be regulated by the same rules covering eligibility as conference games. Other officials were present, but no definite understanding was reached against any violations.

The conference, meeting in "star chamber," session, received the longest report, however, from another Jonathan A. Hitter who found that only 10 per cent of the football players of the coast can be considered amateur under A. A. U. rules.

Toucheing upon the general practice of athletes working their way through college, Hitter said, "I don't think it's inhibited the climate of his report by declining that in two years of investigation there has not been found any instance of an athlete drawing compensation in which he did not perform enough work to justify it."
