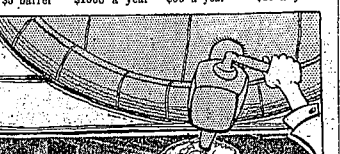

COMMITTEE CUTS APPROPRIATIONS

Big Sum Lopped Off in Effort To Balance Nation's Budget

(Continued From Page One)

...which are \$35,000,000, an amount of \$4,811,887 less than recommended by the budget and \$6,000,000 less than the \$10,000,000 current appropriations. Funds for forest trails and roads were reduced from \$505,000 to \$347,000.

The committee said it was possible that added appropriations might be needed later.

The only important work of the department which would have been funded after June 30 involves the battle against farm pests; planting in national forests, and reclamation of the foot and drug act.

Figures Chopped

Although the budget recommended that \$207,000 be appropriated to pay for the task of collecting real loans of 1931 and prior years, the committee cut the figure to \$180,000.

The committee forbade acquisition of additional funds by the department except those which already are under contract for purchase.

Printing costs and expenses in-
cluding \$257,212 were recommended to be reduced under provisions of the bill.

Compared with current appropria-
tions, the extension increases total to \$60,237, the extension request \$27,212 less, the bureau of animal industry \$24,028, the bureau of date and nut industry \$428,732 and the forest service \$6,802,265.

Recommendations include the bureau of chemistry and soil \$16,482 less, the bureau of entomology \$237,212 less, the bureau of biological survey \$359,397 less, and the bureau of public roads \$187,000 less.

Others to lose would be the bureau of agriculture engineering \$10,853, bureau of agricultural extension \$64,181, bureau of animal industry \$22,622, bureau of plant quarantine \$331,611, and the forest and soil administration \$126,620.
