

WOODROW WILSON
Twin Falls, along with thousands of other citizens in the country, pauses Thursday evening to pay solemn tribute to the memory of that distinguished American statesman and brilliant leader of democracy, Woodrow Wilson, whose seventy-sixth birthday anniversary took place Wednesday.

Had he lived, he would today be entering upon the seventy-seventh year of his life. But he died at sixty-seven, on the third of February, nineteen twenty-four, nearly nine years ago.

Wilson is remembered more for his war service than for any of his other many attainments which made him truly an outstanding American and one of the country's great.

He was accepted as a recognized authority on the science of government long before he achieved personal political fame, his books on that subject and his historical works being adopted as text-books.

As president of Princeton University Dr. Woodrow Wilson again achieved notable distinction, which in itself would have been sufficient to leave his name enrolled on the roll of fame as an educator.

But he did not stop here. His executive ability carried him to the governorship of the state of New Jersey, and thence to the Presidency of the United States.

It is not remembered by many that Wilson, a graduate of Princeton, took his degree in law from the University of Virginia, of which state he was a native son, and practiced law at Atlanta, Georgia.

Rev men achieve fame in more than one art. Wilson is listed among those few.

His scholastic career was no less brilliant than was his political experience. After leaving the University of Virginia with his law degree, he took his Ph.D. degree at Johns Hopkins; taught history and political economy first at Bryn Mawr college and then at Wesleyan University; and for twelve years was professor of jurisprudence and political economy at Princeton University. In 1902 he was chosen president of Princeton and served until October, 1910, when his active political life commenced.

As stated by Dr. Edwin W. Alderman, president of the University of Virginia, in an address some years ago, Woodrow-Wilson was the first great national leader to make the doctrine of unselfish service to humanity the cardinal and guiding principle in world politics. So long as this principle was served by neutrality he kept us out of war. When such a principle could be served only by force, he took us into war.

This principle explains his passionate devotion to the league of nations, to open diplomacy, to self-determination and to democratic government everywhere. This is the distinguishing feature of his administration as president. So long as men love liberty, justice and peace, his name will be revered and honored throughout the world.

A TIME FOR THRIFT


