## SPIRIT OF 1933

An interesting commentary on the spirit which guides the farm-owners on the Twin Falls tract is revealed in their action at the annual meeting of the stockholders of the Twin Falls Canal company here Tuesday in refusing to ask the board of directors for an extension of time in the matter of 1933 maintenance charges.

The opportunity was presented in the form of a recommendation from a resolution committee urging the directors to permit payment of only 50 cents of the maintenance charge April first and to defer the balance of 25 cents an acre until October first.

Most anyone on the outside would conclude that these stockholders would literally "jump at the chance" for an easing up in the method of collection of this annual charge and vote for the resolution. It may or may not be surprising that a dozen of those present took the floor to argue for the payment of the charge in one sum on or before April first; and a majority of those present voted to sustain this course, and against the advice of a majority of the resolutions committee.

All the benefits which would result from a suit payment were pointed out. It was shown that those who wanted to pay all the charge at one time would still be able to do so, even were the opportunity given to defer a part of the fee, but the appeal fell for the most part on deaf ears.

A majority of those present felt that deferring would work a hardship on the company; that somehow and somewhere the ranchers could get the money together as easily by April first as by October first; and that the welfare of the company and its stockholders would be best served by refusing to change the present method of collections.

It is this concern for the canal company on the part of the stockholders which has characterized its entire career, and doubtless is responsible for the great success it has achieved over a long period of years.

And it is this spirit of meeting the issue, assuming the burden and shouldering the responsibility, which guided the founders of this agricultural empire help on a sagebrush plain and attended its citizens through the hardships and successes incident to the development of the tract and the preservation of its resources.

Furthermore, it is the exemplification of this same kind of spirit and attitude which will lead this community, this state and this nation once more back on solid ground in the immediate future. A fine example of fortitude, confidence and security, for others to follow here sprung from a source which logically might be expected to be in the front ranks of the disciples of despair.

The action of the stockholders Tuesday is a heartening and splendid exhibition of the spirit needed by all in nineteen thirty-three.
