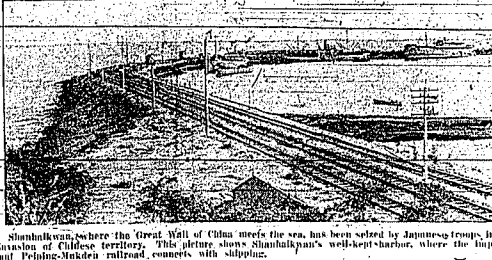
SPORTSMEN GIVE APPROVAL TO NEW COMMISSION PLAN

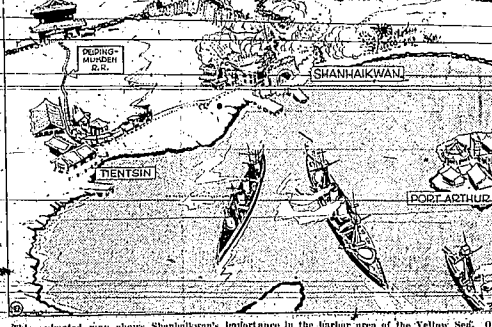

Oregon State Monitor Quits Position After Conference With Dr. Kerr

COVINGTON, Ore., Jan. 11 (11P)—Paul Schissler, head coach of the Beavers for the past two years, resigned today after a conference with Dr. W. C. Kerr, state chancellor of higher education, yesterday.

Schissler encountered the most difficult situation in his coaching career last fall when Oregon State defeated only Southern in conference play, and lost to Washington and Detroit in intercollegiate football.

Schissler's contract here would have expired in 1932. The immediate resignation of Schissler was believed to have been Dr. Kerr's consent that he accept an offer from the University of Oregon.
