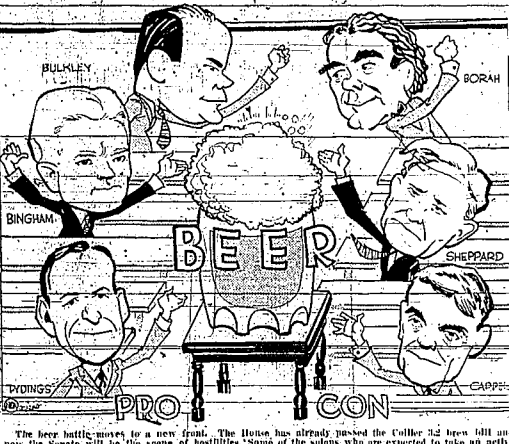

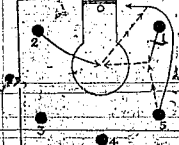

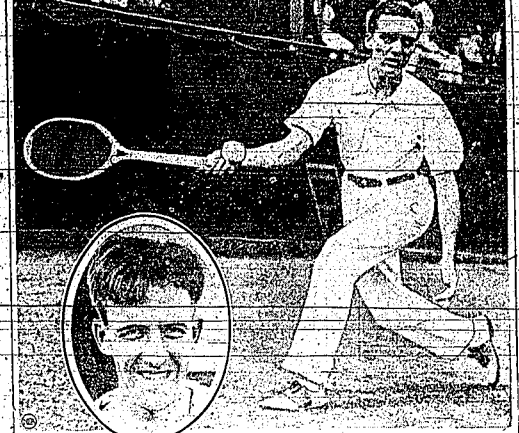

The deficiency judgment is a second advantage that the mortgage holder gets by foreclosing in the midst of a depression when farm products are at beggar's prices and farm land in the bottomless pit.

Of course, every debt into which the mortgaged man enters is a debt of honor and should be paid. Nobody should be a reprobationist. The mortgage note is a sacred obligation.

But won't the confidence necessary to good times come back a lot faster if the great companies that pay their mortgages rest until the mortgaged man can pay? Recurring foreclosures of mortgages keep the communities in terror.

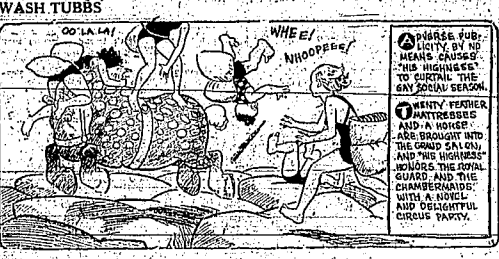

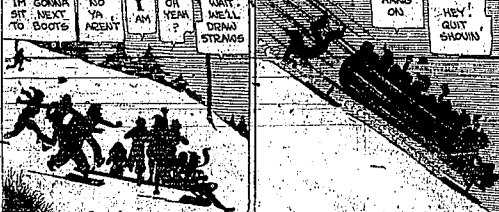

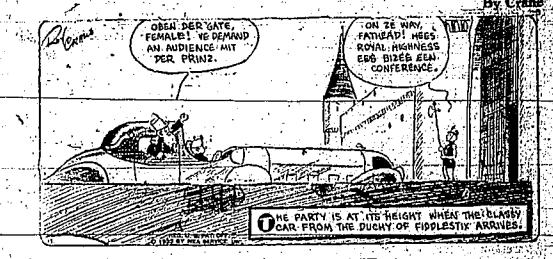
