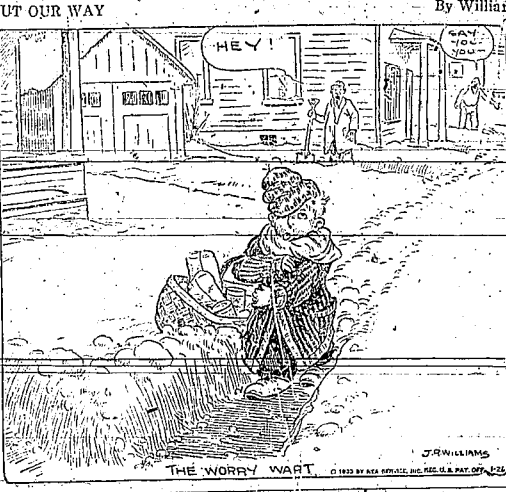

"OUTLAW WAR"—WHAT, AGAIN?
 The newspapers recently reported that a letter signed by Frank D. Rowland, American, has been received by the U. S. Senate, demanding that a measure to "outlaw war" in international law be pushed through to a quick passage.

Here, indubitably, is a worthy cause. But events of the last two or three years might well make one cynical about the amount of good such a movement might actually accomplish. Have not the nations of the earth signed a pact solemnly renouncing war as an instrument of national policy? And does not war still flourish, regardless?

As long as the causes of war remain, elaborate peace pacts are apt to be rather ineffective. Diplomats can always get around them. The newest stunt is to make war without actually declaring war. When it gets stoppeworn another one will be found. It will take more than a nicely worded treaty to abolish war from the world.

PROGRESSIVE GOVERNMENT
 Ratification of the "lame duck" amendment to the Constitution is another evidence that America is growing up.

It has been contended that the organic law of the land has not kept pace with the advancement made in other lines. To this charge, the nation and every state stands convicted.

While we have made great progress in science, the arts, in transportation, industry and economics, we have been handicapped by archaic law, which literally is the relic of horse and buggy days.

There has been reluctance to alter the impositions of our fathers as regards law, but an ambition to excel them whenever any other activity was involved. This situation has resulted in many of our present inconsistencies and can only be remedied by an intelligent effort to not permit government to lag behind other activities of society.

The reactionary principles which have guided our national government ever since Woodrow Wilson occupied the Presidential chair, must be abandoned and are. The changed attitude is evidenced by such acts as freedom of the Philippines and adoption of the "lame-duck" measure. Some others to which immediate attention must be given include recognition of Russia, a mild expansion of the currency, war debt settlement, remonetization of silver, the breaking of trade barriers, and the restoration of world commerce.

The situation requires fearless leadership, and progressivism personified, but nothing else will answer.

Fortunately this nation is on the threshold of some of these possibilities, afforded by the new administration about to come into being.

JUDGING FAME BY ITS SHADOWS
 When John Masfield, the English poet, landed in New York not long ago, the newspapers recorded how in his youth he had worked in a water-front saloon there; and this prompted F. P. A., the columnist, to remark that "ten times as many of his know that John Masfield once worked in a saloon as are able to quote two lines from one of his poems."

In this sardonic remark there is a good deal of truth; and it applies not only to Masfield but to all manner of people who enjoy prominent positions.

Fame, nowadays, is apt to be a peculiar thing. It thrusts the name of a man before thousands of people who care for the least interested by what man does, and as a result it is apt to make some of his best known attributes.

We know all about Masfield's saloon job, but as the columnist remarks, we can't quote his poetry.

We know exactly what Einstein looks like, we know that he is a devout pacifist; but not one of us in a hundred could give an intelligent description of the work that has made him famous.

We know that Dr. R. A. Millikan is a scientist who believes in God, but if our lives depended on it we couldn't say what his cosmic ray theory is all about, or what his implications are.

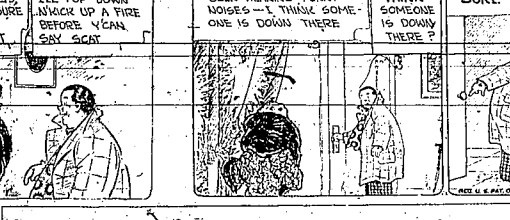
