After the incident, which came after a 210-mile-an-hour drive, were not finished.

When the giant racing machine was taken apart, it was found Sir Malcolm was not to blame.

He was ready to go yesterday, but today

many of his ship's vital parts

were still strewn about the beach.

The delay means that Sir Mal-

colm has only the faintest chance

of taking the car out before Sun-

day, but he is determined

that he may be afforded an opportunity to open the record up on Sunday.

For the only time he will go on Saturday will be afforded to the beach at the start of the race.
