Local people who have been burdened with the responsibility of administering this relief have no excuse. They have plenty of work on their hands keeping all elements satisfied and satisfied are subjected to criticism which they must be big enough to either disregard if untrue, or act upon if warranted.

The whole thing goes back to the proposition that everyone has his problems—officials, businessmen, housewives, laborers, farmers, and the destitute. Each of these groups manifests its difficulties by different means. The wonderful thing is that it is never necessary to resort to violence or unlawful methods, and the splendid attitude of the American people in all the new problems with which they have been confronted is the most heartening revelation of the present times.

One thing that all can be thankful for is that there has been ample funds upon which to draw and none should be more thankful than those who are receiving direct relief. Were it not for this generosity of the part of the federal government, it is hard to realize just how the problem could have been successfully met.

It is not to be expected that the method of handling each detail of the charity work would conform to every individual's idea or that a broad policy would exactly suit every beneficiary, but there is much satisfaction in the knowledge that this community through contributions made by the public through charities from the county and the national government, is doing its level best in this time of stress to meet the needs of its own people and to tide its population through the winter until the arrival of Spring, with its milder weather, its opportunities for employment and a clearing of the economic skies, which Lord knows cannot come too soon for all of us.

The problem of keeping these funds flowing in is serious enough in itself for those having the matter in charge without the addition now of new complications which are certain to have only a harmful effect.
