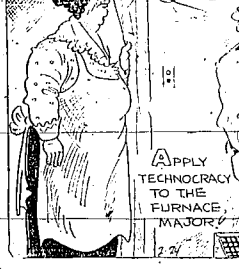

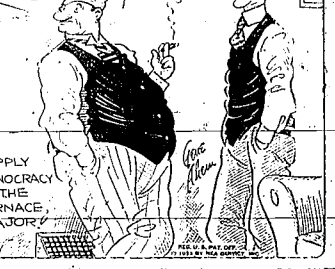

LET'S NOT FORGET THIS LESSON The revelation that Samuel Insull and members of his family were able to make a paper profit of \$25,000,000 on a single transaction in one of the Insull investment trusts is a bit of news that ought to be engraved on stone tablets and preserved for reference after the depression is over.

Right now it has an unreal, other-worldly sound. Nobody is making profits like that these days, on paper or otherwise. It is a little bit hard to remember that there actually was a time when such things did happen.

But it wasn't so long ago, after all—only a matter of four years. With any kind of luck, another four years will bring us to a point where such things once more are possible. And when that glad day comes we ought to consult the stone tablets, a little thinking, and see to it that such shenanigans are prohibited.

Some economists have asserted that the country isn't really sick now. The real sickness, they say, came in the years just before the stock market crash of 1929. This news about Insull seems to support that view.

The general mass of people in this country have never quarreled greatly with the theory that it is necessary to hang up very large rewards for achievement in the world of business and industry. If a man serves capably in that world, we have always felt that it was only fair that he be paid accordingly.

But a stunt of this kind is something else again. In view of what has happened to the Insull holdings up and to the Insull investors, since those bright days of 1929, it is a little hard to assert that Insull's squiggles to the public put him in line for any very overwhelming reward. This simple twist of the wrist by which a few insiders profited \$25,000,000 on the flotation of a new security issue is not the sort of thing that belongs in any sound economic order.

Well, it happened. It happened in a good many places during the boom years. And we're paying for it right now. No matter how soon we get back on the path to prosperity, we ought to make up our minds that get-rich-quick tricks like his are out, from now on.

- HISTORY OF PROHIBITION The history of the prohibition movement in America follows: Dec. 18, 1917—The 18th amendment to the constitution was submitted to the states by congress. Jan. 8, 1918—The first state, Mississippi, ratified the amendment. Nov. 10, 1918—The wartime prohibition law designed as a measure to conserve grain during the war was enacted. Jan. 16, 1919—The 36th state, Nebraska, ratified the amendment. June 30, 1919—Wartime prohibition law became effective. Oct. 9, 1919—Congress passed the Volstead national prohibition act to enforce the 18th amendment. Oct. 28, 1919—Congress passed Volstead act over President Wilson's veto. Jan. 17, 1920—Eighteenth amendment and the Volstead act became effective. Nov. 23, 1921—The Willis-Campbell act strengthening the prohibition act became a law. Feb. 19, 1929—The Jones law, an amendment making more drastic the national prohibition act, was passed by the Senate. Feb. 28, 1929—The House passed the Jones "Five and Ten" law. March 2, 1929—President Coolidge signed the Jones law. July 1, 1930—Administration of the prohibition law was transferred from the treasury department to the department of justice under the Williamson act. Dec. 16, 1930—U. S. District Judge William Clark of Newark, N. J., ruled the 18th amendment was unconstitutional, as it was unconstitutionally ratified being done not by state conventions, but by state legislatures. Feb. 24, 1931—United States supreme court by unanimous vote reversed Judge Clark's decision, ruling Article five of the Constitution gave Congress the sole power to specify the method of ratification. March 14, 1933—Beck-Linthicum resolution for returning to the states the right to continue or abolish the 18th amendment voted down in the House. Dec. 5, 1932—Garnier resolution for outright repeal of the 18th amendment voted down in the House. Feb. 16, 1933—Senate passed Blaine resolution to repeal the 18th amendment. Feb. 20, 1933—House passed Blaine resolution repealing the 18th amendment, when the action is ratified by three-fourths of the states.
