GOOD BEET YEAR

The added security which comes with the announcement of the bureau of entomology here that this district may expect to be comparatively free from the white fly pest this season, is among the welcome bits of news lately.

While the predictions cannot by the very nature of things be inevitable, it appears safe to assume in the light of facts known to all, including the severity of the past winter, that the ravages of the white fly can be expected to be minimized.

This means then, that this section may expect another successful sugar beet crop, with the promise of a three-months' campaign at the sugar factory next fall.

It means, too, if the contract now in controversy is ever agreed to by the manufacturers, that assurance is practically given of a favorable cash crop for the ranchers of south-central Idaho.

Experiences of the past two or three unsatisfactory agricultural years here, have done much to impress the advantages of diversification, and have emphasized again the benefit of the sugar factory in the locality and the opportunities this crop provides, not only for a splendid type of diversification, but for a guaranteed income in a time when that item is particularly hard to get.

Every resident, as well as every farmer, can take increased satisfaction in the report of Dr. J. C. Chamberlin and increased hope that this favorable factor will be but a fore-runner of the promise 1933 holds for this agricultural district.

THE GOOD OLD DAYS

No one can analyze successfully perhaps the reason for the present craze for jigs-saw puzzles.






