### GOOD BEET YEAR

The added security which comes with the announcement of the bureau of entomology here that this district may expect to be comparatively free from the white fly pest this season, is among the welcome bits of news lately.

While the predictions cannot by the very nature of things be inevitable, it appears safe to assume in the light of facts known to all, including the severity of the past winter, that the ravages of the white fly can be expected to be minimized.

This means then, that this section may expect another successful sugar beet crop, with the promise of a three-months' campaign at the sugar factory next fall.

It means, too, if the contract now in controversy is ever agreed to by the manufacturers, that assurance is practically given of a favorable cash crop for the ranchers of south-central Idaho.

Experiences of the past two or three unsatisfactory agricultural years here, have done much to impress the advantages of diversification, and have emphasized again the benefit of the sugar factory in the locality and the opportunities this crop provides, not only for a splendid type of diversification, but for a guaranteed income in a time when that item is particularly hard to get.

Every resident, as well as every farmer, can take increased satisfaction in the report of Dr. J. C. Chamberlin and increased hope that this favorable factor will be but a fore-runner of the promise 1933 holds for this agricultural district.

### THE GOOD OLD DAYS

No one can analyze successfully perhaps the reason for the present craze for jigs-saw puzzles.

Fads are always difficult of interpretation, for reason here plays little part. Certainly no craze lasts for long which is not basically appealing or beneficial or entertaining.

But it is interesting to note that jigs-saw puzzles are not of recent origin. We do not know their history nor do we care much as to this feature of the fad, but their present vogue is a revival of a pastime which consumed the attention of our fathers and mothers and grand parents too.

All of us have never hesitated to chide the pastimes of our forebears; to talk of horse and buggy days; of bustles and hoop skirts; of fiddlers and cotton stockings; of brie-a-brac and whiskers.

But the older generation now living, must get real enjoyment and satisfaction in seeing this so-called modern age revisiting the customs and the paraphernalia of the past in music and art, in styles and habits, in song, handwork and pastimes.

The most stylish furniture now is an antique; fancy quilting is again coming into its own we are informed by the feminine members of the newspaper staff; hooked rugs are quite the thing, even hooked dresses, etc.; then note the feminine trends in dresses of you will, and in hats, if you know what we mean.

Listen to the current radio and dance music and you will be taken back at least fifteen to thirty years. We thought the tunes pretty then, and now this generation has proved it, by emulation. And the customs of the present go to prove that revival is the surest mark of approval of the customs and the foibles of the past.

That is the biggest lesson of the jigs-saw puzzle craze, just as the "believe it or not" references are in tribute of the old-fashioned almanac.

This generation may be modern, it may be "hot," but it is good to know that it is not above taking a leaf from grandmother's scrap book, and finding its greatest pleasure and delight in indulging in the habits, the pleasures and the pastimes of a generation which in its day was quite as resourceful, if not more so, than we so-called moderns.

### GOING THE WHOLE WAY

Litvinov, foreign commissioner for Soviet Russia, asked universal agreement to a plan by which all war would be outlawed. Signatory nations would agree not only to discard all "offensive wars," but would pledge themselves not to go to war even in self-defense.

That such a treaty could get accepted by the great powers is probably very doubtful. Yet the events of the last few years seem to indicate that an anti-war treaty would do much good if it does not carry away nations equally strict. We have so far only outlawed all offensive wars, only to discover that all wars nowadays are defensive warfare as well, or treaties aren't apt to do much good.

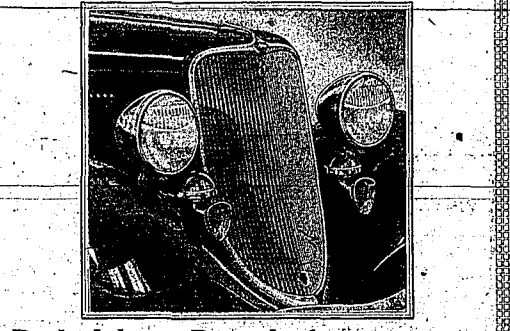
