Business Women's clubs of Idaho are making special preparations for the observance of the week, by providing large give dinners and other interesting special affairs of local newspapers.

### Chief Officer—Shot Through—Officer by Brigands in Far East Waters


HONGKONG, Feb. 28 (AP)—The Danish steamer, Gustav Nordenskiöld, returned to port today after being seized by pirates who looted the vessel and three fighting officers, kidnapped six crew members and a cargo of bullion.

"Taking command of the vessel," the pirates boarded the ship at Hongkong about for Boston. Two hours after, they shot Chief Officer Nielsen through the forehead. Captain and other Danish officers were imprisoned.
