This naturally suggests the thought that there is no need here for anything but a clean-cut, open and above-board campaign. Twin Falls and all her citizens will be the better for it. The brief period before the election is devoted to a campaign of education in municipal government, with clear presentations of programs, policies and principles.

As this newspaper has said before, regardless of the result, it is highly desirable and to the best interests of the community that there be contests for such important offices as mayor and councilmen. A fair opportunity for expression of popular opinion is always a wise safeguard.

No doubt all candidates for office in the city election April 4 have not been heard from, but it is good to know that we already have something tangible to think about. At least we are assured that no one faction has been successful in prematurely controlling the election. It's going to be a wide open race and may the best men win!

### THE FARM IMMIGRATION

During the last two years the agricultural population of the United States has increased by nearly 650,000 men, according to reports drawn up by economists at Chicago. This is largely due to the movement of the unemployed from city to the country—motivated, no doubt, by the fact that no matter how bad the depression may be the man who grows his own potatoes and raises his own chickens is at least going to escape starvation.
