HOUSE APPROVES BEER BILL; NOW GOES TO SENATE

Lower Chamber Rushed Bill Through This Afternoon

LITTLE DEBATE IS HEARD

Beverage May be on Sale Inside of 20 Days If Senate Acts Speedily

WASHINGTON, March 14 (UPI)—Legislators in the House were impressed today by an overwhelming vote of Representatives. The vote was 316 to 97.

The chamber passed the Calumet Beer bill and sent it on to a friendly Senate. Legislator leaders were surprised by the legislative speediness, marking the immediate modification of the Volstead act to provide a new source of revenue have joined in pledging final support to the measure before the end of the week.
