AN OPPORTUNITY

Twin Falls residents have opportunity in the election Tuesday to pay tribute advantageously to long years of faithful service by their behalf by a prominent fellow-townman, C. D. Thomas, candidate for mayor.

It is only fair to him that the citizens of his city be reminded of the unexampled service he has given this community over a period of some twenty-eight years.

As a pioneer resident and business man he is the epitome of the Spirit of Twin Falls, which brought it the blessed name of 'The Magic City' in recognition of the contributions he has made to the welfare of this district he was made president several years ago of the Old Settlers' Society of Twin Falls county, a position which he still holds, and which distinction is in itself recognition of the respect in which he is held.

But his long residence here is perhaps the least of his qualifications for the job he has consented to seek. Ever alert to his responsibilities as a citizen, he has always taken an active interest in public affairs and is entirely familiar with practically every detail of local government; knows the needs of Twin Falls and her citizens as few men do, and has a record which needs no defense for loyalty, industry and pride for the city of which he long has been and now is an important part.

There is no discounting that over a period of twenty-eight years here, associated as he has been on one side or the other with every important public question, he at times has aroused the displeasure of some individuals or groups. That is the penalty of fearlessness.

Today Twin Falls needs a leader with that same type of courage, one who can clearly see the path of duty and chart a rigorous course of economy without fear or favor. Like most cities rich now Twin Falls can use just such a fighter to eminent advantage, and no one who knows Charley Thomas will say he is not also experienced, qualified and deserving of being mayor of Twin Falls.

In his public address at the Legion hall he displayed a keen insight into municipal affairs and won high commendation for his handling of a subject having multitudinous angles. Being a forceful speaker, the city would never lack for an advocate, were he mayor. In the Thursday evening speech referred to he made a straightforward, honest, presentation of his views, laying his cards on the table, and outlined a sane, intelligent program. It is to be expected that some will not agree with every one of the many policies he advocates, but he has outlined a course which should meet with public approbation Tuesday.

In presenting his appeal he urged and emphasized the necessity for full support for colleagues on his ticket, Messrs. Lincoln and Patrick running for councilmen, to the end that the proposed economy policies may be carried into effect.

There is merit in the contention that the position of mayor of this city for one which in all justice should be changed frequently, at least every two or three terms, and that to repose this responsibility in one person over a continuous period of eight years reveals an unhealthy civic situation, especially when there are capable successors available.

That is a question for the people to decide Tuesday, and judged by the heavy registration they are out for a change, just as they were last fall. There is dissatisfaction, else there would not have been four tickets in the field, nor would the electorate have been aroused as it is today.

C. D. Thomas as his running mates, Ivan G. Lindcoln, and Lloyd L. Patrick, represent the vital principle of what the administration candidates stand for. In their election Twin Falls would not only secure officials with strong personalities, and proved records in public office, but in placing Mr. Thomas in the Mayor's chair it will be acknowledging appreciation for the services and ability of one of its first and foremost citizens, and will have conferred a deserved honor upon him and upon the city he has given the best years of his life to promote.

Portraits of the four local majority candidates, exhibited by the photographer in a recent street window equally attract the admiration of the most critical. One can't go so far as to say that their beaming countenances are particularly handsome—in fact there is little to be said, excepting that they are a tribute to the photographer's art!

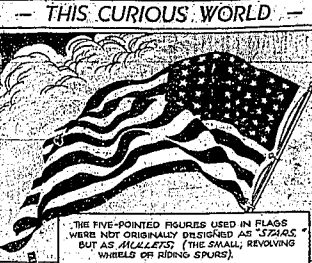

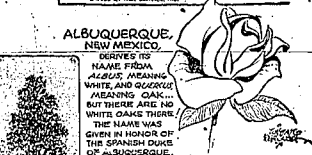
