EASTMAN BREAKS WORLD'S RECORD

Stanford Luminary Better Mark of Douglas-Lowe In 600 Yard Race

SAN FRANCISCO, April 3 (UP)—A new world record was established today by Bill Eastman, Stanford luminary, who won the 600 yard race in the record time of 1:09.2 during a charity sport event here Saturday.

The spectacular Stanford star's performance bettered by one and two-tenths seconds that of Douglas-Lowe, British middle-distance luminary, who established the record of 1:10.4 in 1926.

Three watches set by Pacific coastling officials checked Eastman, across the tape. Officials planned to initiate a formal bid for recognition which may encounter difficulties because of a slight wind that might have the field during the performance.

The wind gauge registered 2.3 miles per hour, according to U. A. officials, asserted that the record was set rather than aided. Eastman is the sixth Stanford luminary to set 500 yards with the wind on his side.

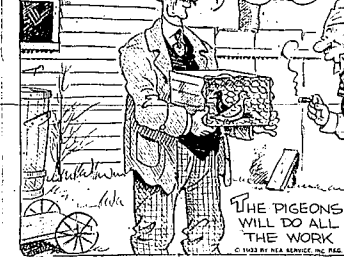
