WASHINGTON, April 22 (UP)—Return of fixed monetary exchange standards and recognition of the dollar as the basis of international trade is the main message of a visitor from the British government.

With an hour after he reached the White House to begin his momentous conversations, the prime minister said his country had long desired to discuss with the United States the possibility of a new monetary arrangement. He said the problem would be thoroughly explored.

"This was in answer to a question regarding reestablishment of the international gold standard."

Meantime, Mr. Macdonald's visit is in answer to a question which continued to be asked of the general economic problem. He placed no special emphasis on the question, however.

"Tomorrow he and President Hoover are expected to spend the entire day, practically alone together, conferring on the problems of the world economy," it is reported from Washington.

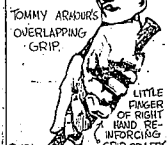
