DOLLAR'S VALUE DIPS ON LOONION AND N.Y. MINTS

LONDON, May 6 (UPI)—The dollar sank to a new low yesterday when Britain abandoned the gold standard in 1941, with a pound of silver worth \$1.0254 at the close. The pound opened at \$2.85, up one-half cent, and closed at \$2.8450.

Gold and the French franc reached 47 cents, against a parity of 33 cents.

NEW YORK, May 6 (UPI)—American dollars today dropped to the lowest level since reversion of specie payments in 1933, and the sterling advanced to 44½ for the first time since September, 1932.

Jesus Faces The Cross

April 29th, 1933
The International Uniform Sunday School Lesson for May 7.

Editor of The Congregationalist.

It would be interesting if we could know whether the cross was as closely associated with the crucifixion as the narrative of the discourses of Jesus before his arrest and trial ahead of them. He was evidently deeply engrossed in thought, and there was something that the discourses were both amazed and afraid.

Jesus took them aside and told them of his tragic forebodings.
