

TWO EXPERIMENTS IN GOVERNMENT

TWO EXPERIMENTS IN GOVERNMENT
One more nation seems to have decided that the right of the individual count for nothing in the high-ly-organized society of the industrial era. Germany, under a Faseist dictatorship, takes a leaf from Stalin's book and mobilizes labor, takes over labor unions; and prepares to control all the big industries from top-to bottom.

This scheme, which is nothing less than astounding in its scope, may mark the beginning of a new chapter in the history of human society. The combined parallel and contrast between Faseist Germany and Communist Russia is one of the most interesting sights the world has ever been permitted to watch. Russia, acting by and for the man at the bottom of the ladder, turns an entire nation into one vast productive machine.

Germany, whose government seems to represent

Germany, whose government seems to represent chiefly the man at the top, does precisely the same

chierly the man at the oppositions, these two countries have adopted almost identical vehicles.

The development begun when James Watt put his steam engine on the market has carried mankind a steam engine on the market, has carried mankind a long-way, has hought it through some carinas scenery, and now, at last, seems to have brought it to a great fork in the road. Russia has gone one way, Germany is starting down the other; and the most important question before the race today is whether these are the only two paths available.

Must we all follow either Germany or Russia? Must am industrial society, in the very 'nature of things, crush the last trace of individual freedom and choose between hard-boiled Communism or ruthless Fascism? Or is there, by good luck, a third road? The answer depends largely on our own United States.

We have started, amid social changes that we have We have started, amid social enanges that we nave-hardly beginn to understand, along a third road. We elling to the notion that it is possible to maintain an intricate industrial society without discarding the old ideals of liberty and individual initiative. Our "new deal," if it is to mean anything, must mean that we are now beginning a stupendous effort to prove that the notion is justified.

BACK TO THE FARM

A new trend in "buying for future profit" is accelerating the well established "back to the farm" movement in the northwest according to Ward K. Newcomb, head of the land department of the Federal Land Bank of Spokane. An analysis of land sales made during the first four months of 1933 in the four northwest states disclosed the fact that professional, business, and tradesmen from the cities are buying farm land, in an increasing number. The volume of sales for the first four months of 1933 totaled \$765,565_s.urpassing all previous like periods, excepting that of 1928, since the bank's origin in 1917.

"Most of the city people do not plan to go on the farm, but rather rent the newly acquired property to responsible people, receiving this added indome as well, as the expected future profit." Newcomb says. "Others have put dependent relatives out on a farm where the opportunity of life in a healthy almosphere would be constructive in building moral courage for fighting back to an independent livelihood. It will also furnish both families with sufficent farm, produce. The related tenants can also increase the value of the investment, by a spare time improvement program."

Some will say there is too much farm land already, while others may maintain there are too many people. Since we have both in large amounts no one can deny it is a good thing for everyone to be as self-supporting as is possible.

OUR DEBT BURDEN

Figures on the national debt issued by the Twentieth Century Fund, which is headed by Edward A. Fillene of Boston, show, in a striking way the enormous burden which the nation is trying to carry out

mous burden which the nation is trying to carry out of the depression.

Long term indebtedness in the United States to-day, according to these figures, amounts to 40 per cent of the national vaulth, requires 20 per cent of the national income and is one of the major obstacles to economic recovery.

Corporations, government agencies and individuals share in a long term indebtedness of \$134,000,000,000, as compared with \$75,000,000,000 in 1921.
