Another "Dred Scott" Case Looming in Negro's Extradition Trial at Boston

BOSTON, Mass. (U.P.)—The right of white-intruders justice in Boston to prosecute the extradition of a trial which the State of Virginia wants to carry on a Negro murder suspect in the history-making problem which will confront the U. S. Circuit Court here soon.

The human black pawn in this grim legal game—who may become as famous as the Missouri slave, Dred Scott in the celebrated court conflict of 1857—is former George Crawford, a former slave in Virginia.

Wanted in Middleburg, Va. for the brutal murders of wealthy Mrs. Agnes Fleming Hiley and her elderly maid, Crawford temporarily has found Massachusetts to be a legal haven, since Judge James Aronoff Lowell started the country by granting a writ which prevented the Negro's extradition.

Mass. There were many who were convinced that no legal nonsense was attached to the requested extradition. Governor Pollard of Virginia assisted Governor Ely of Massachusetts to send the prisoner down to the state. Governor Ely signed the writ. And later the U. S. House of Representatives voted 200 to 100 for an impeachment inquiry into Judge Lowell's conduct in refusing to extradite the Negro.

The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People delivered Virginia's demand for the delivery of Crawford by seeking a writ of habeas corpus. Judge Lowell, holding that Virginia does not want Negroes on its juries, and that such trials therefore are unconstitutional, granted the writ. Virginia authorities fully retorted that Negroes are legally eligible for juries.

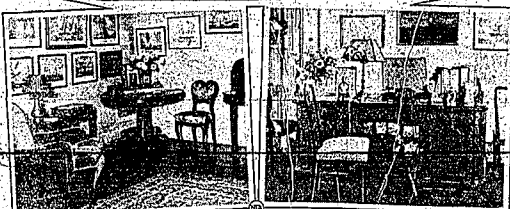
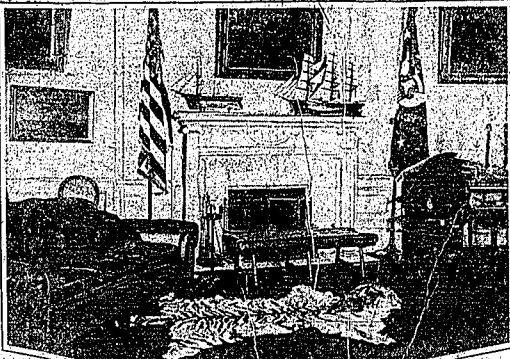

ROOSEVELT LEADS

The action of President Roosevelt in stepping into the breach at the psychological moment in his history-making messages of Tuesday gives indication of the precarious situation into which world affairs have fallen.

To even the casual thinker it must be apparent that the world at the present time is engaged in war—not in fact, but economic—and that many of the penalties of military warfare are now being exacted, and in a form exhibited.

Nationalism is growing strong; armaments are to the fore; governments are burdened with the costs of past wars, and many of the current political questions have to do with problems arising out of war, such as pensions, veterans' legislation and bonus army matches; and in addition the depression has brought its toll of dead, its misery, despair; while the battle for economic supremacy is being waged quite as strenuously as are military battles, citing Russia, for example.

In the midst of all this we have the problems arising out of the Far East, the South American conflicts, and the rumors of actual war in Europe.

Certainly a strong hand is needed now, with Hitler coming to the fore and with the world a seething mass of conflicting views.

President Roosevelt has supplied that leadership and has again demonstrated the strength which traditionally has originated in America.

It is good to know that he is possessed of such simple courage and such statesmanship, and that his action and his words reveal the attitude and the spirit of America and the cherished hope of the American people.

AMERICA'S NAVAL STRENGTH

While the Administration looks forward to an extensive disarmament agreement with foreign nations this summer, the general board of the navy issues a report declaring that "the growing inferiority of the American navy is a matter of serious concern, and urging the immediate construction of 48 warships.

Thus once again we find ourselves in one of those peculiar situations where the necessities of the moment seem to urge two diametrically opposed courses of action upon us.

That there is a very strong and widespread desire in this country for armament reduction is equally widespread. There is also, however, equally widespread, an uneasy feeling that in the present state of things it is the part of wisdom to keep our powder dry and our boxing gloves hand, just in case somebody starts something; and how these two feelings are to be reconciled is perplexing.

As the navy's general board points out, a navy's strength is relative. You can't figure it unless you assess the strength of the navies maintained by other nations. And it is the board's conclusion that in every class of ships, except battleships our navy is inferior to the navy of England and Japan.
