

## ÎT'S THE AUTO DRIVER WHO IS UNSAFE

If there were any indication, anywhere, that the American motorist was beginning to learn how to drive in safety, the figures on traffic fatalities would drive in safety, the figures on traffic fatalities would not be so discouraging. We could say, in that case, that the long list of deaths came simply because the auto still was a relatively new bit of machinery, and that things would work themselves out, once everybody got the hang of it.

But we can't say that. An claborate analysis of 1933 auto accidents, issued recently by the Travelers Insurance Company, shows that our driving is getting worse instead of better. For from learning how to handle our cars in safety, we are making a worse record now than six years ago.

Look at the figures. In 1927 there were 23,200,000 aftos in just in the United States. In 1933 the mini-

attos in use in the United States. In 1933 the muni-ber was 23,800,000—an increase of only 2.6 per celt. In 1927 auto accidents killed 25,533 people; in 1933 they killed-29,900—which is a rise of 17 per

These figures can mean only one thing: That we achally are driving with less care today than we were six years ago. Far from learning how to handle these new machines, we are getting wose. Patalities are increasing at a faster rate than aato registra-

are increasing at a faster rate than anto registrations.

This belief is borne out when the factors involved in the accidents are examined. It is revealed, for instance, that near 33 per cent of the 29,960 people killed in 1933 died in accidents in which drivers were exceeding the speed limit.

Eighteen per cent of the deaths came when drivers when off the road. Thirteen per cent were caused by vehicles being on the wrong-side of the rad; an equal percentage came from some driver's failure to give the right of way to a vehicle entitled to it.

Those figures are utterly damning. They prove, as clearly as any black and white tabulation could prove, that our auto death toll is going up because of criminal carelessness and self-sinness on the part of the drivers.

Number of cars in use is only slightly higher than it was six years ago. The cars thenselves are far safer; they are solider, their trakes are better, they stick to the road better, they are easier to keep under control. It is the human element, and it alone, which has failed.

We must find some way of protecting ourselves from our own foolishness.

### EUROPE'S PRESENT PERH.

It is along time since the sky has been as dark as it is today, and it is hard to see how it could be very much darker. Remembering what the last war did to eivilization, it is not easy to contemplate the approach of a new one without the most profound misgivings.

ZToday's situation is not like that of 1914. In that day the world not yet had had its frightful demonstration of the catastrophe which war brings to victor and vanquished alike; nor was the imminence of war a matter of general knowledge, exent among affectatively small group of statesmen. Those very one, down to the most ignorant peasant, knows that war is near, knows that if it comes it will mean complete disaster for everyone involved. Is one being a blind optimist in supposing that this general awareness may create a pressure on the rules of Europe that will lead to the adoption of more sane policies?

gIn 1914 the world did not realize its own peril. Today it cannot help realizing it.

End the disorder, the bloodshed, the menaces which recent weeks have brought may, just-possibly bring the statesmen of Europe to their senses.


