





ELECTION CHANGES

Welcomed is the significant change in the elec-tion laws which this year puts the date of the pri-maries in August instead of in May, as was the case

two years ago.

Had the law not been changed by the last legis-Had the law not been changed by the last legislature all the counties of the state would now be involved in the processes of the biennial election, for two years ago March 25 was the opening date for the filing of candidacies. As it was then the election program was dragged out over an eight month period, for the final election came in November. This year, with the primaries in August, and filings opening in June, the period will be plenty long, but it could not be hoped to have it much shorter. As is well-known the remoteness of the primary date this year, has not delayed "election talk," and already there is agitation for candidacies, not only in congressional and state offices, but in the counties as well.

The shorter the period of the campaign, the better

as well.

The shorter the period of the campaign, the better for the people. The longer the term of office, generally speaking, the better for everyone concerned, also, for with short two-year terms, officials are hardly on the run of their jobs until they are faced with the necessity of seeking re-election.

It has been argued in this state, and rightfully, that the term of the governor should extend for four years. The question was voted upon once, and carried, only to be thrown out by the supreme court on a technicality.

When the campaign warms up this summer and fill, will be time enough to give to the impending election, but meanwhile the public should not forget the blessing its enjoys from a deferred primary
