FIREPROOF CLOTH FOUND POSSIBLE

Italian Experiments Succeed In Treating Wood and Silk Fabric

NEW YORK, May 12 (Special) - Experiments in treating cotton and flammable material as cloth, wool and the like were performed successfully at the Royal Institute of Genoa, Francesco Vitale, New York lawyer and American representative of the patent-owning firm, has announced.

The inflammable material was subjected to a fire test which limited its combustion to carbonization, thus preventing the spreading of the fire. Vitale said.

Experiments conducted at Genoa recently with two wood samples, one of which was submitted to the fireproofing, gave tangible results. Fibers were protected from damage even after immediate burning. The treated door burned slowly, flameless.

Experiments made with artificial silk cloth gave identical results. Not only the pre-treated cloth charred slowly, but the projected flame failed even to perforate the cloth.
