Planning commissions, such as those inaugurated several weeks ago by the City of Twin Falls, and this week by the state, evidence an awakening of latent resources which is certain to prove of inestimable benefit

A look is taken into the future; needs are surveyed; plans are correlated; and a semblance or order is sought in preparation for future building. Adahouis getting down to business. It is bringing some jof, its talent into use in planning for development, and in attempting to capitalize on its manifold resources.

The state needs more people, lower taxes, cheaper transportation and simpler government from top

to flottom.

That is the program which the planning commission, should undertake. The resources of irrigation water, mines, timber, agriculture and water power can be made to attract a greater population, through development. 




