



Evening Times news stories and a Public Forum letter reveal that there is need for attention being given the county plot at the cemetery, located near the I. O. O. F. cemetery at Filer.

The project might well be sponsored by some ambitious organization, anxious to contribute to the general well-being of the community.

There is nothing which arouses the sympathetic consideration of people quite so much as the final resting place of their dead. It is certain that the county authorities would welcome the cooperation of a responsible organization in correcting the situation. Failing that, it is possible that the caretaker of the Filer cemetery could be employed at an additional small cost to look after the plot; or, some competent citizen, now on the old age pension list, would be glad to assume the task of beautifying the grounds.

Here is a project, small in scope, but large in importance, which the entire community will be glad to see given the consideration it deserves.

Business failures in May, according to the Dun and Bradstreet reports, fell to the lowest number since January, 1920. The total liabilities involved in the failures was correspondingly less. This seems to show increasing steadiness in the business world.

And one of the big airlines, operating between Chicago and New York, now has put in effect a "commuters' schedule" with 16 planes a day each way between the great cities. That seems to indicate that the airmail rumpus hasn't permenently crippled air transport. air transport.






