Thousands of children are being engaged at a few cents a day, in preference to adult labor.

All of which is a reminder that the child labor amendment to the constitution still awaits ratification.

It is interesting to note that government statistics issued in Tokyo show that the rate of population increase in Japan is slowly slackening.

The growth in population in 1933 was under that for several years. The birth rate declined slightly, and the death rate rose a little.

It is too early, of course, to say that Japan is approaching the point of a stable population.

The terrific pressure of new population is forever forcing Japan to seek new lands, new resources, and new markets.

Until the island empire's amazing rate of population growth subsides, this condition will continue.
